Fourth Episcopal District of the AME Church License MVR Request Approval Form

Underwriting requirements include but are not limited to:

- All Drivers must have less than 6 points on their Motor Vehicle Report for the past 3 years.

 A driver that has been charged with a DUI (Driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs) will not be approved.

 A suspended or revoked license will not be approved.
- Do driving standards include the following:
 - No major violations for the past three(3) years including racing, hit and run, speeding in excess of 20 mph over posted speed limit, manslaughter.
 - No Alcohol or DUI related violations for the past five (5) years.
 - > No more than one minor moving violation within past three (3) years.
 - No more than one at fault accident within past three (3) years.
- Drivers must follow the guidelines listed below:
 - No driver under the age of 21 must be allowed to drive on behalf of the Church
 No driver under the age of 25 will be allowed to transport children.

 - Drivers over the age of 80 can be submitted to the Underwriter for review along with Physician's report of driver fitness.
 - Youth Pastors or directors between the ages of 21-25 must have NO moving violations in the prior three (3) years.
